Overview

BayCare Health System is a family of health care providers consisting of the nine leading not-for-profit hospitals in the Tampa Bay region. With 17,000 team members and a wide array of other health services, we are the area's largest community-based health system.

History

BayCare was formed in 1997 when the finest not-for-profit hospitals in the Tampa Bay area came together under one name, united by a common mission. The hospitals knew they had to keep providing patients more while spending less in order to keep pace with health care's rapidly changing fiscal environment. As a united health system, the nine hospitals save money by consolidating and sharing duplicative non-patient care services, such as purchasing, human resources and financial services. As a result, BayCare has saved more than \$90 million in its first five years, far exceeding the stated financial goals when the health system was formed.

In addition to cost savings, BayCare also created a very unique model for a successful health system. BayCare is a joint operating agreement between three Community Health Alliances, or CHAs. Each CHA uniquely focuses on the distinct needs of its community and taps into the regional system for improved quality, better access and greater efficiencies.

Organization

BayCare's CHAs are:

- **Morton Plant Mease Health Care**, which includes Mease Countryside Hospital, Mease Dunedin Hospital, Morton Plant Hospital in Clearwater, and Morton Plant North Bay Hospital in Pasco County.
- **St. Anthony's Health Care**, which includes St. Anthony's Hospital in St. Petersburg.
- **St. Joseph's-Baptist Health Care**, which includes St. Joseph's, St. Joseph's Children's and St. Joseph's Women's hospitals in Tampa, and South Florida Baptist Hospital in Plant City.
